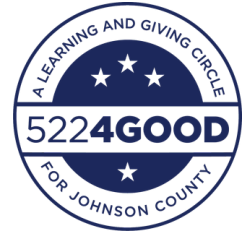


5224GOOD GRANT GUIDELINES 2026
